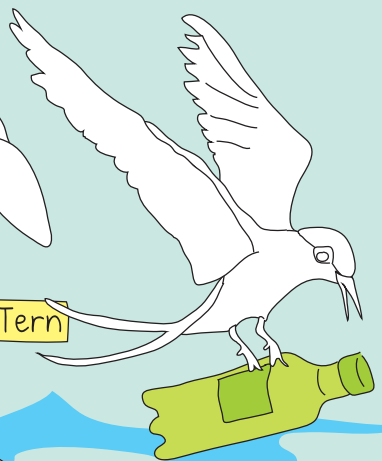

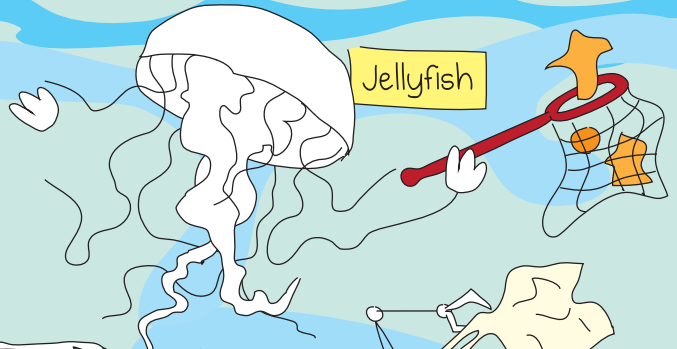

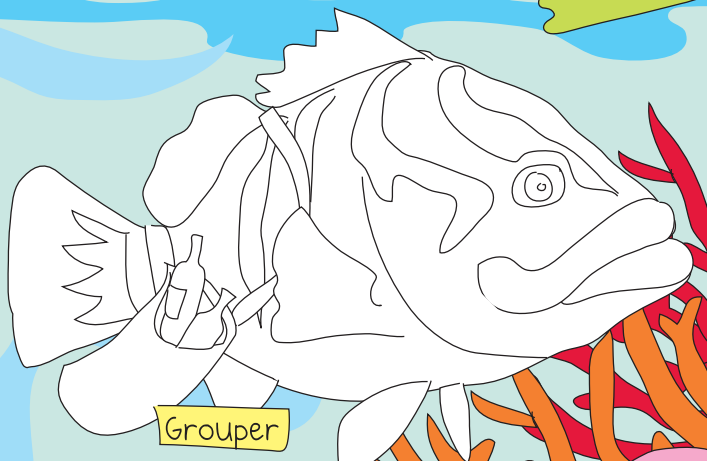
OCEAN COMMOTION

Let's celebrate World Oceans Day! Here is a picture of the beautiful Great Barrier Reef. Colour in some things you might find there.

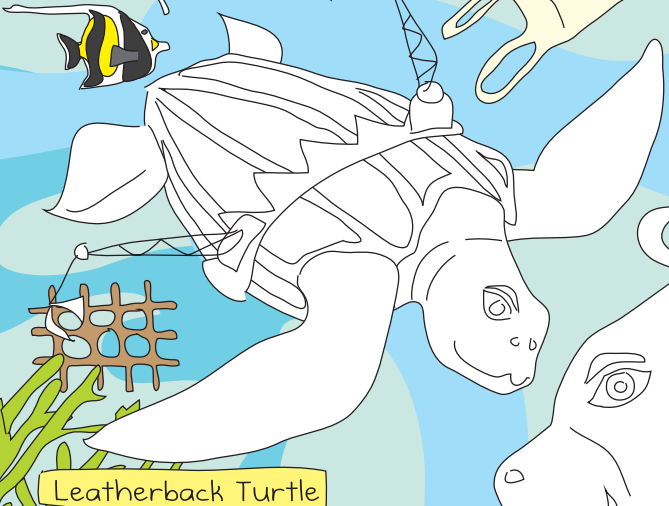

Australia is home to some amazing ocean environments and marine creatures. But many are under threat from pollution. What can you do to help protect our oceans?



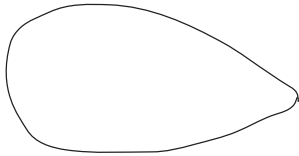

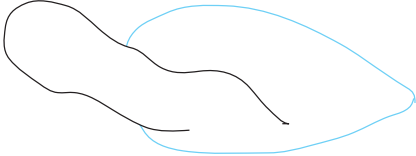
HOW TO DRAW A GREEN TURTLE

Follow these simple steps to draw a green turtle in the area to the right.

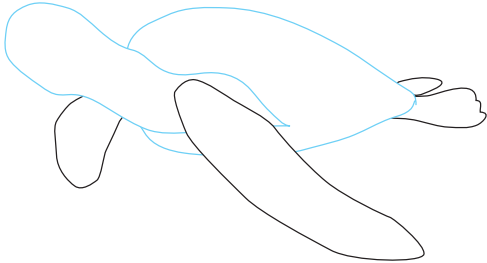
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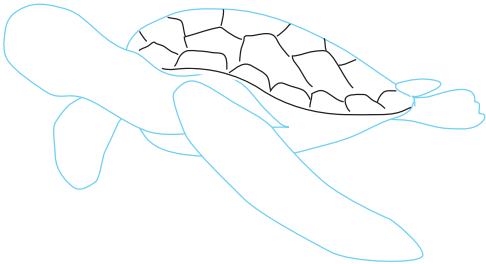
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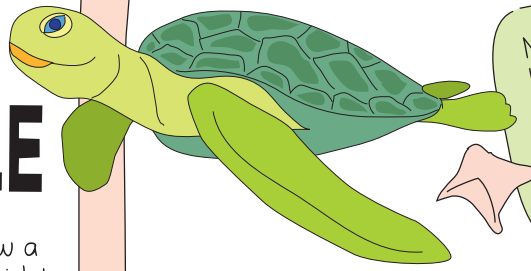
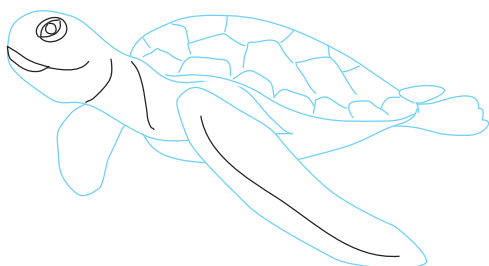

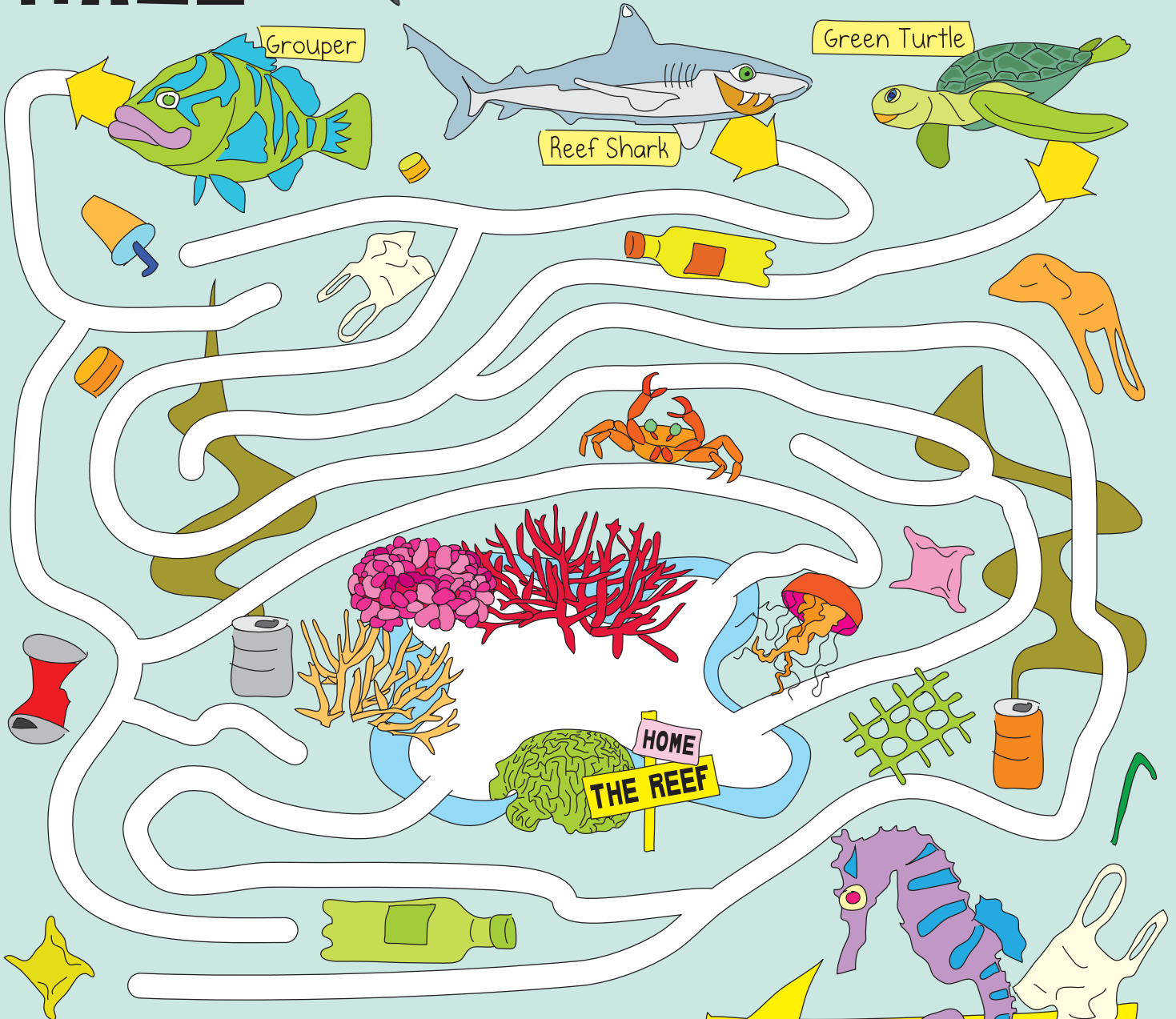
OCEAN COMMOTION MAZE

Draw a line to mark their path. See if you can name the different types of creatures and pollution too.



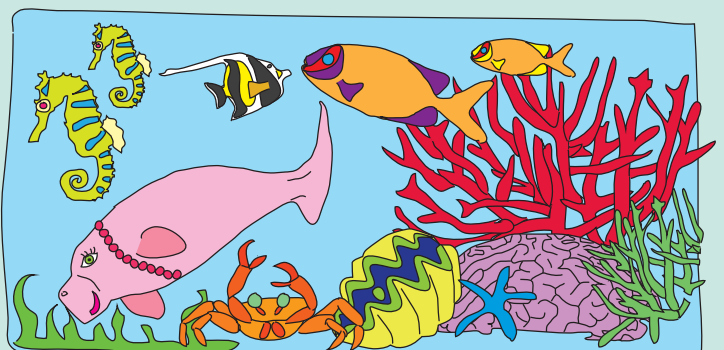
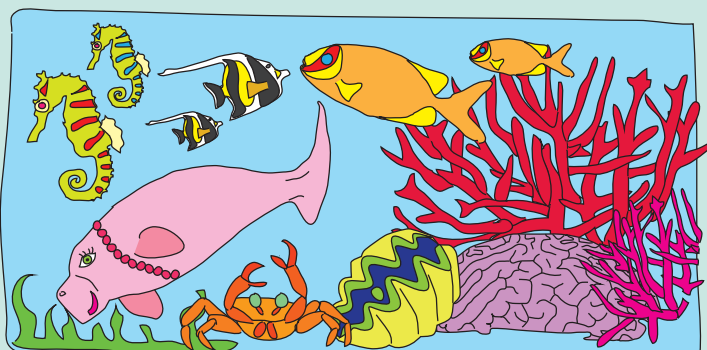
LOOK, SEA, SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

Where would they live?

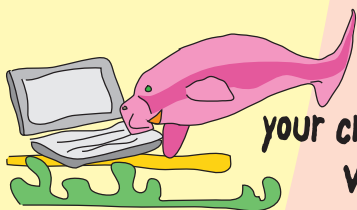

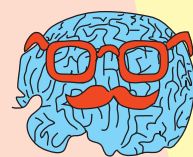
