

# MAKE YOUR OWN CENTURION'S HELMET

Dress like a Roman soldier.

## MATERIALS

- Copies of this template printed or pasted onto A4 cardboard
- Scissors
- Sticky tape or a stapler
- A strip of cardboard approx. 2.5 cm wide and 25-35cm long

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Step 1

Carefully cut around the dashed lines on the template on the next page

### Step 2

Sticky tape or staple your helmet to the cardboard strip as shown in the illustration.

### Step 3

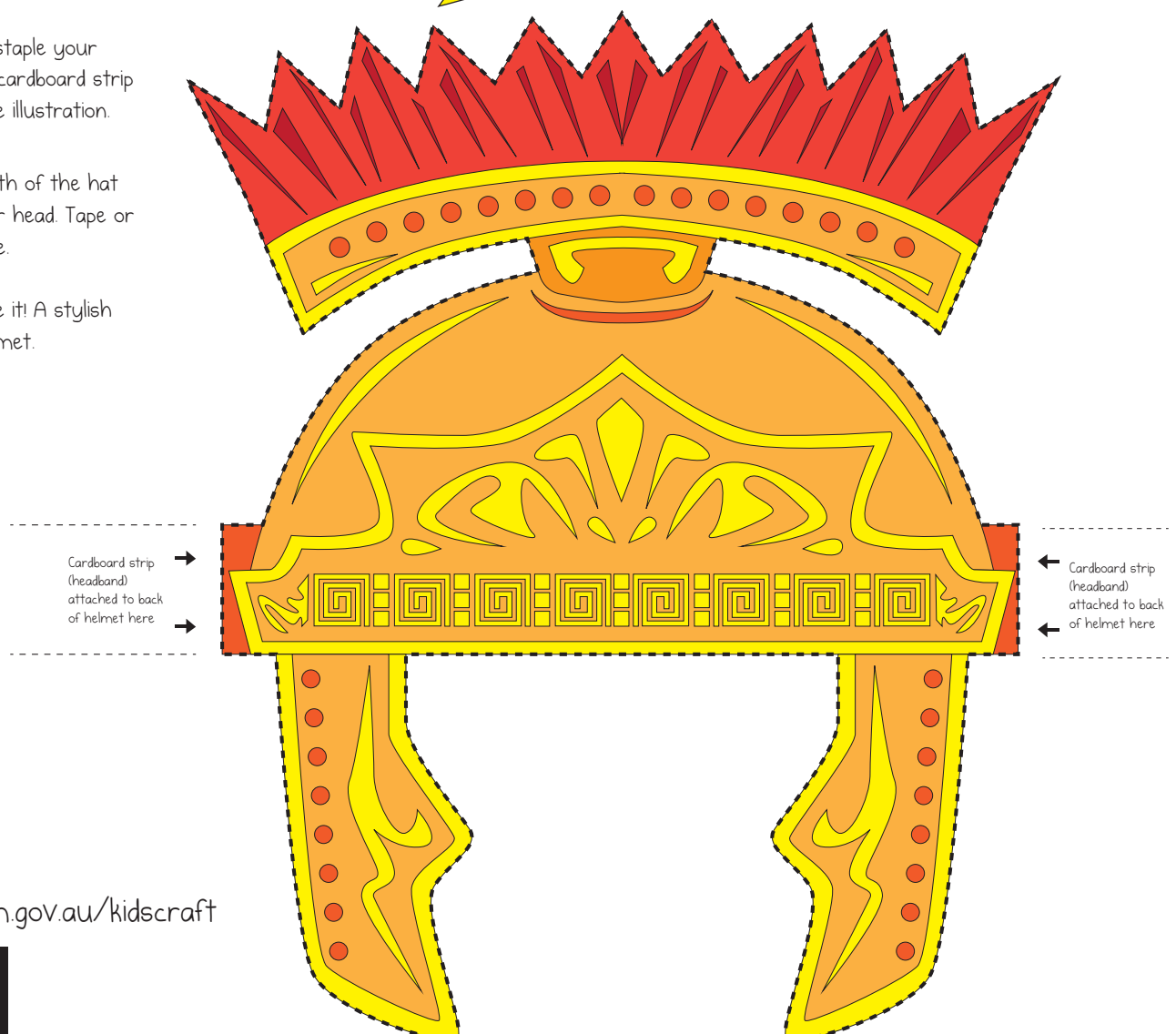
Adjust the length of the hat strip to fit your head. Tape or staple into place.

There you have it! A stylish centurion's helmet.
