HOW TO MAKE A SUBMARINE-SPY PERISCOPE

MATERIALS

- periscope template (in your kit)
- square pieces of mirror (in your kit)
- collage paper, stickers, shapes (in your kit)
- Glue stick (in your kit)
- Sticky tape

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Decorate the periscope with stickers, coloured paper or camouflage patterns



2. Fold your periscope along the fold lines and join the edges together with sticky tape



3. Glue a piece of mirror inside each of the mirror flap sections.



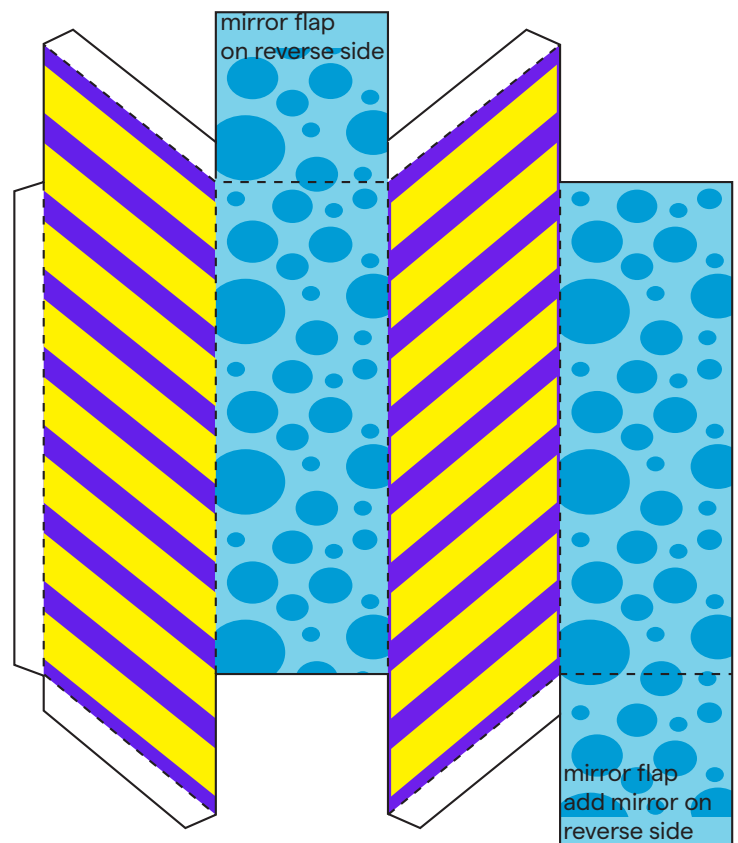
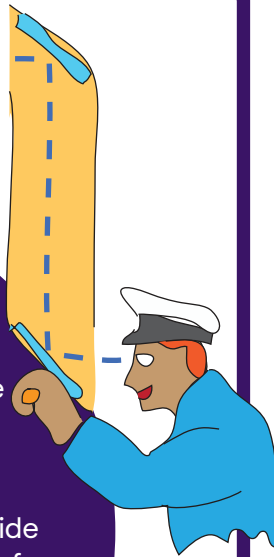
4. Fold in the mirror flaps so that the mirrors face in to one another. Sticky tape mirror flaps into place.

Okay it's time for some stealthy submarine spy action... Up periscope!

DID YOU KNOW?

Most submarines have a periscope so that the crew can see above the surface of the water.

Periscopes have also been used outside of submarines throughout history, like for seeing into a secret bank vault, seeing underwater from the land (to draw fish), for peering above the trenches in WW1 and even to spy over sandhills on a golf course.
